1. On 08.01.2024, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Through the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer is made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.350, dated 18.12.2023, under Sections 380 and 454 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the name of the petitioner was figured in the FIR after two months of the occurrence, and infact the present case is an outcome of a financial dispute, and even the CCTV footage, as alleged in the FIR does not establish the guilt of the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Mohit Chaudhary, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and waives service.

Adjourned to 28.02.2024.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and on his doing so, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so, and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions to him by ASI Kewal

Singh, submits that the petitioner has already joined the investigation in pursuance to the aforesaid order, and she has fully co-operated with the investigation process, and even the final report has also been filed, and she is no more required for any further custodial investigation.

3. In view of the specific stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed, and order dated 08.01.2024 is, hereby, made absolute, on the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
