DEEPAK SIBAL, J (ORAL)

1 Through the present petition, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to the Municipal Corporation, SAS Nagar, Mohali (for short 'the Corporation') to implement the interim orders (Annexures P1 to P4) passed by the Disputes Redressal Committee (Municipal Bhawan), SAS Nagar, Mohali (for short 'the Committee').

2 Mr. Rohit Gupta, Advocate, who appears on advance notice for the respondent-Corporation does not dispute the fact that the dispute raised by the petitioners is pending before the Committee and that the interim orders (Annexures P1 to P4) have also been passed by the Committee. However, he states that the Corporation is contesting the dispute raised by the petitioners and is sanguine that at the time of final adjudication the Corporation would be successful.

3 For the grievances raised by them against the action of the Corporation, the petitioners have approached the Committee which has admittedly passed interim orders in their favour. Only because the Corporation is contesting the petitioner’s claims does not clothe the Corporation with any right not to comply with the interim orders passed in the petitioners’ favour.

4 In the light of the above, the present petition is *disposed of* with a direction to the respondent-Corporation to comply, in letter and spirit, the interim orders passed in favour of the petitioners by the Committee.

5 Needless to add that the afore direction by us would be subject to the final orders to be passed on the petitioners’ grievances by the Committee.
