This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for violation of interim order dated 31.05.2006 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Collector, Ambala.

Status report dated 04.09.2023 filed in the Registry is taken on record.

Pursuant to previous order dated 04.12.2023, Dr. Shaleen, Deputy Commissioner, Ambala is present in the Court and filed his status report along with receipt of costs of Rs.25000/- deposited with the Institute for Blind. The same are taken on record.

Perusal of the status report shows that the order passed by this Court has already been complied with and the applications filed by the petitioners under Section 13 -A of the Punjab Village Common Land Act have since been decided.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any reason or ground to continue with the present petition any more.

Dismissed.

However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left un-addressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
