Prayer in this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.67 dated 02.02.2019, under Sections 166, 180, 218, 420, 465, 447, 467, 468, 341 and 120-B of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

On 04.03.2024, following order was passed:

“Learned State counsel informs that a Special Investigating Team has been constituted, so as to investigate the matter and that the petitioner may be asked to join the investigation.

Adjourned to 09.04.2024 for filing status report.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join investigation and co-operate in the same. He will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor shall make any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any witness associated with the case. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C”

Today learned State counsel, submits that petitioner has since joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but



without commenting anything further on the merits of the case order dated 04.03.2024 is hereby made absolute, whereby petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
