VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus by directing respondent no.3 to submit the internal marks of the petitioner qua his 3rd semester of Master of Physical Education and further directing respondent no.2 to declare the result of the petitioner of his 3rd semester by accepting his internal marks of 3rd semester from respondent no.3.
2. A perusal of paragraph 13 of the petition would show that the petitioner has been informed that his degree has been cancelled, however, no prayer on the said aspect has been made by the petitioner. Even the relevant rules and regulations have not been annexed with the present writ petition.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after making appropriate prayers and after giving full and better particulars.
3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
4. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
