Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No.185 dated 19.11.2019, under Section 307 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860; Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar.

(2) After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to accept the prayer, learned Counsel for the petitioner on instructions submits that present petition be disposed off as not pressed at this stage; but in view of the long custody of petitioner, learned trial Court be directed to expedite the proceedings.
