1. On 14.10.2024, this Court passed the following order:-

“Print out of order dated 20.12.2023 passed by the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Bathinda is taken on record. A perusal of the order shows that the objections filed under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 have been accepted and award dated 21.05.2019 passed by the learned Arbitrator has been set aside.
