**RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)**

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 14.05.2001 passed in CWP-6896-2001.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents has produced copy of order dated 22.08.2002 passed by Division Bench of this Court, vide which, the main writ petition itself has been dismissed.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more. Hence, the same is dismissed.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order passed by Division Bench of this Court.
