The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail pending trial to the petitioner in Criminal Complaint (Annexure P-1) bearing registration No.SC/171/2019 (Date of registration 04.06.2019) under Sections 363, 366-A, 376, 120B IPC, 1860 and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 as the petitioner has been summoned vide order dated 23.12.2022 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Special Court, Hoshiarpur in the above-mentioned criminal complaint, wherein now charges have been framed against the petitioner under Sections 120B, 363, 366, 376D of the IPC, 1860 and Section 17 read with Section 6 of the POCSO Act, 2012, vide order dated 12.09.2023 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly submitted that the petitioner has already been convicted vide order dated 28.03.2023 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur and hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. In light of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
