1. Instant petition under Section 482 Cr.PC has been preferred seeking directions to the official respondents to close the false complaint lodged by respondent No. 5 against the petitioner.

2. Heard.

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that on account of some grievance with respondent No. 5, the petitioner had moved a representation dated 01.12.2023 (Annexure P-1) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, Punjab, but no action on the said representation has been taken.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-1).

5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gurpreet Singh Sandhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents.

7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sangrur, Punjab, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 01.12.2023 (Annexure P-1), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
