1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 28.07.1999 passed by in CWP-10260-1999.
2. There is no representation on behalf of either of the parties.
3. Perusal of the paper-book shows that the present contempt petition has been filed for alleged non-compliance of the order of maintaining status quo. The order passed by the Writ Court, qua which the contempt is alleged, is of such nature for assessing non-compliance whereof, a lot of disputed questions of facts would be required to be adjudicated upon. However, adjudicating upon the disputed questions of facts is not appropriate in the contempt proceedings. Otherwise also, the present petition is pending before this Court since 2009. Therefore, the present proceedings have lost efficacy on account of efflux of time as well.
4. In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition any more.
5. Dismissed.
