

Learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file appeal in accordance with the provisions of Section 51 (5) of the Act. However, he submits that the petitioner be granted liberty to plead all her available grounds. He has submitted that the marriage of son of the petitioner is fixed for 05.02.2024 and thus, she be given liberty to file the appeal within five weeks and interim protection be granted to her till then.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the petitioner is allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file the appeal taking all the grounds available to her. In case the petitioner files the appeal alongwith the stay application within two weeks from today, the Appellate authority would decide the stay application expeditiously in accordance with law. The impugned order dated 29.12.2023 be kept in abeyance for a period of two weeks from today enabling the petitioner to file the appeal alongwith stay application as submitted above.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
