The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to direct the respondents not to take any coercive steps against them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the complaint has been filed by respondent No. 4 against the petitioners, however, the contents of the said complaint have not been disclosed to the petitioners. Rather they are being harassed by the local police in collusion with respondent No. 4. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that respondent No. 4 was his power of attorney holder earlier and a civil dispute is there between both the parties.

On advance notice, Ms. Navreet Kaur Barnala, AAG, Punjab has appeared on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. On instructions from ASI Baljit Singh, learned State counsel submits that a complaint was received from respondent No. 4, however, the matter has been closed by the police. She further submits that the petitioner shall not be summoned in connection with the said complaint submitted by respondent No. 4, at this stage.

In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the petition is, accordingly, disposed off.
