Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has filed petition (Annexure P-1) on 05.04.2023 under Section 25 of the Guardians & Wards Act, 1890 for the custody of minor daughters and upon notice respondent appeared on 10.08.2023 before the Family Court and case was adjourned for 11.12.2023 for filing written statement and on that date the proceedings were again adjourned to 14.03.2024 for the same purpose. He further submits that petitioner would be satisfied if the learned Family Court may be directed to dispose of the petition in a time bound manner.

4. If notice is given to the other side it may further delay the disposal of case and may further put financial burden upon respondent.

5. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the concerned Family Court to dispose of the application for interim custody filed along with the petition under Section 25 of the Guardians & Wards Act, 1890 in accordance with law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. It is ordered that the Court may if necessary prepone the matter after giving notice to the parties through counsel. The petitioner is directed to appear in the learned Family Court on 23.01.2024.

6. The present petition stands disposed of.
