1. COCP-1919-2017 has been filed under Sections 10 and 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the orders dated 16.05.2015, 17.12.2016, 25.01.2017, 21.02.2017, 16.03.2017, 18.04.2017, 20.04.2017 and 19.05.2017.

2. COCP-1629-2019 has been filed under Sections 10 and 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 16.05.2018 passed in CRM-M-12844-2018.

3. Counsel for respondent No.1 has produced the calculation sheet and has submitted that the amount has already been paid to the petitioner, pursuant to the order(s) of the concerned Court.
