SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE(Oral)

1. The present appeal assails the order dated 26.10.2018 passed by learned Single Judge in CWP-1801-2013, whereby the dispute with regard to termination of the workman in question was remanded to the Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Panipat for reconsideration and for passing fresh orders in accordance with law.
2. We have heard learned counsel for rival parties and have perused the records.
3. Learned Single Judge has rendered certain factual findings which learned counsel for appellant-employer apprehends, may come in way of Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court in adjudicating the dispute afresh in a fair manner.

4. In view of above and the consensus arrived at between learned counsel for the parties, we dispose of the present appeal by upholding the order of learned Single Judge with the observations that any factual finding rendered in the impugned order dated 26.10.2018 passed in CWP- 1801-2013 against any of the party shall not prejudice the Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court while considering the dispute afresh. Since the dispute is more than 20 years old, learned Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Panipat is expected to decide the matter on priority basis and expeditiously.
5. Appeal is disposed of in the above terms.
4. All the pending application(s) also stand disposed of.
