Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short “Cr.P.C”) for grant of interim bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No.33 dated 10.04.2023 registered under Sections 15-C, 25 and 29 of Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station, Maur, District Bathinda.

2. As per case of the prosecution, 240 kgs poppy heads was recovered from the possession of petitioner and his co-accused Paramjit Singh @ Pamma.

3. Learned counsel contends that due to extreme cold weather, petitioner is suffering from pain, loss of blood and other necessary minerals on account of vomit and loose motions.

4. *Per contra*, learned State counsel while opposing the prayer of the petitioner, submitted that recovery is very heavy in this case and petitioner is facing two more cases under the NDPS Act.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper-book.

6. The recovery alleged against the petitioner is 240 kg poppy heads and he is involved in two more cases under the NDPS Act, the details of which

are as under:-
