1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that they are entitled for regularization of their services with all consequential benefits as per the regularization policy dated 01.10.2003 (Annexure P-3) especially when the petitioners fulfill all the requisites of the said policy to claim regularization.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance through legal notice dated 19.09.2023 copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-9 but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Rathee, Senior DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 19.09.2023 (Annex. P-9) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is

still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision, the petitioners are found entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to them within a further period of four weeks, otherwise due reasons for not accepting the claim will be mentioned for the information and necessary action for the petitioners.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. Ordered accordingly.
