1. In the present petition, the only grievance of the petitioner is that he has not been granted the benefit of extension in service though the said benefit has been extended to the other similarly situated Data Entry Operators (Contractual) while passing the order dated 21.12.2023 (Annexure P-12).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that once, the benefit of extension in service contract has already been granted to the similarly situated Data Entry Operators (Contractual), declining the said benefit to the petitioner is arbitrary as no reason has been given so as to differentiate the petitioner from the others, who have been granted the extension in service.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, any representation is received

from the petitioner with regard to the non-extension of his claim, appropriate order will be passed by the authorities concerned within a period of six weeks from the date of the receipt of any such claim and in case, after examining the claim, any relief is to be given to the petitioner, the same will be granted to him within a further period of four weeks, otherwise due reason will be given in the speaking order itself for the information of the petitioner.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
6. Ordered accordingly.
