1. Through the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. the petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.141 dated 18.11.2023, Under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the very outset submits that he has earlier sought the relief of regular bail under the provisions of Section 306 IPC, which was declined by the learned trial Court concerned vide order dated 5.12.2023 (Annexure P-5). He further submits that now on dated 20.4.2024, Section 305 IPC and Section 3(2) of of the Schedule Castes and



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Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act of 1989, have been added by virtue of lodging of DDR No.34 dated 20.4.2024.

3. In view of the supervening events, the petitioner is required to seek regular bail for the newly added offences, therefore, the instant petition is **dismissed**, however, the petitioner is relegated to re-approach the learned trial Court concerned, for seeking regular bail in the aforesaid offences.
