This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 27.07.2012 passed in CWP-14201-2012.

Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the order order dated 27.07.2012 passed in CWP-14201-2012 has been complied with and necessary order dated 02.07.2019 has been passed. Copy of said order has been placed on record in connected case i.e. COCP-419-2019.
