1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to respond to Legal Notice dated 10.10.2023 (Annexure P-11).
2. The petitioner is claiming that his father was working with respondent as Class IV employee and passed away in harness on 18.01.2015. He is entitled to terminal benefits on account of death of his father.
