1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 14.02.2017 passed in CRM-M-20759-2016.

2. Today, the case was listed in kacha peshi for effecting service upon respondent No.6. However, on the request of learned counsel for the parties, the main petition is taken up for hearing.

3. Learned counsel for the parties have submitted that the order passed by the Coordinate Bench dealing with the criminal aspect, has already been stayed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

4. In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to keep the present petition pending.
