1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing order dated 21.09.2020 passed by District Magistrate, Jind, notice (s) dated 06.10.2018 (Annexure P-1) issued under Section 13 (2) and 12.03.2019 (Annexure P-4) issued under Section 13 (4) of Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (for short 'SARFAESI Act'), order dated 05.03.2021 passed by respondent No.6 and notice dated 22.11.2021 (Annexure P-8) issued by respondent No.7 i.e. Kanungo, Halka Safidon.

2. Learned counsel for respondent – Bank, on instructions from Mr. Anirudh Sangwan, Branch Manager, Safidon Branch, submits that this writ petition is rendered infructuous as petitioners' account has been settled.

3. Learned counsel for petitioners submits that he does not have any instructions in this regard.

4. Be that as it may, in view of categorical statement made by learned counsel for respondent-Bank, we find no justification for continuation of present proceedings.

5. Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous. In case, any incorrect fact has been placed before us, petitioners are at liberty to file appropriate application within four weeks.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
