In response to the notices, Mr. Rishabh Gupta, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the appellants and filed his power of attorney which is taken on record.

As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.3,50,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. Learned counsel further submitted that the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.2-Ram Niwas S/o Laxman Singh, for & on behalf of all the claimants, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance to deposit cheque in the sum of Rs.3,50,000/- favouring appellant No.2-Ram Niwas S/o Laxman Singh with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the counsel for the appellant/appellants.

Appeal stands disposed of.
