- 1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC with a prayer to direct the official respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the matter and take appropriate legal action against the respondents No.4 to 6.
- 2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 06.12.2023 (Annexure P-1) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Union Territory Chandigarh-respondent No.2 and he shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.
- 3. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Union Territory Chandigarh, to look into the representation (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate action within two months, in accordance with law.
