RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 15.07.2022 passed in CWP-14975-2022.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Ashima Brar, Director General, Social Justice, Empowerment, Welfare of SCs and BCs and Antyodaya (SEWA) Department, Haryana, filed in the Court today, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 15.07.2022 passed in CWP-14975-2022 has been complied with and speaking order dated 31.01.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
