1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in a cross version i.e. DDR No. 31 dated 17.10.2023 registered under Sections 365/379/323/148/149 of IPC, Police Station Amir Khas, District Fazilka(Annexure P-4) in a case arising out of FIR No. 44 dated 19.07.2023 under Sections 323/148/149 of IPC, Police Station Amir Khas, District Fazilka(Annexure P-1).
2. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mahender Singh submits that in the present case, the cross version has been investigated fairly and only the offences under Sections 323,325,148,149 of IPC have been added, which areailable in nature. Learned State counsel further submits that four persons have been formally arrested in the present case and the police has issued notice to three accused to furnish bail bonds. He has further

assured the Court that after appearance of the said 03 accused, the final report of investigation shall be presented before the competent Court without any delay. He has further assured the Court that DSP, Jalalabad will not interfere with the investigation of the present case.

3. In view of the above, nothing survives in the present petition and the petition is accordingly disposed off.

4. Needless to observe that the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail his legal remedy, if any, in accordance with law.
