1. Instant petition has been preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus, for release of the detenue namely Muskan, aged 21 years, daughter of Vikram resident of H.No. 289 Sector 25-D, Chandigarh, who has been abducted by private respondents.
2. Heard.
3. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the sister of the petitioner, namely Muskan, had disappeared on 01.01.2024 along with some jewelry articles besides Rs. 2.00 lacs in cash. Apprehending that she had been abducted by the private respondents, the petitioner had moved the representation dated 06.01.2024

(Annexure P-1) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, U.T. but till date no action has been taken thereon.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if the directions are issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 06.01.2024 (Annexure P-1) in an expeditious manner.

5. Notice of motion.

6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Viranjeet Singh Mahal, Addl. P.P. UT, Chandigarh, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that representation dated 06.01.2024 preferred by the petitioner will be considered and decided in accordance with law by Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh.

7. Heard.

8. After hearing the respective submissions; considering the averments made in the petition and without commenting on the merits thereon, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 06.01.2024 (Annexure P-1) and dispose of the same in an expeditious manner under the provisions of the law after giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner.
