1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 24.05.2016 passed in CWP-9344-2010.

2. Counsel for the respondent has produced the calculation sheet to show the difference of salary payable to the petitioner w.e.f. 01.02.1987 to 31.07.1987 and, accordingly, cheque No.957762 dated 09.05.2024, amounting to Rs.5314/- in the name of Smt. Sushila Bhatia, has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner, on account of payment towards difference of salary for the suspension period. The remaining payment has already been paid to the petitioner.

3. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more



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- 4. Dismissed.
- 5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
