1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with the prayer to quash the order dated 30.09.2015, passed by Ld. JMIC, Jalandhar (Annexure P-10) whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender.

2. The petitioner is still to comply with the direction given vide order dated 31.01.2024. Despite, couple of extensions granted on different dates, learned counsel for the petitioner has not come to the Court with clean hands since there is no effort made after the expiry of the period of 8 weeks from 31.01.2024. Neither any application seeking extension nor further effort were made to seek another opportunity till date all these conduct of the petitioner is sufficient enough to show that the petitioner is not approaching with the clean hands and thus he does not deserve the concession of protection of law.

3. The present petition stands dismissed.
