1. Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.228 dated 17.04.2023, registered for the offence punishable under Section 379-A of IPC, 1860 at Police Station Urban Estate, Hisar, District Hisar.
2. As per the allegations levelled in the FIR, it has been alleged as under:-

“To, The In-charge Police Post Urban Estate-II, Hisar. Respected Sir, it is requested that myself Kanta wife of Satish Kumar is resident of 81 DC COLONY, Hisar. Today on dated 17.04.2023 at about 08:15 P.M., I had gone to purchase vegetables from DC MC rehri market and when I was going to rehri market and was crossing Radhe Dairy then a boy came on motorcycle from backside and while going snatched away my purse from my hand. I was having 400-500 rupees in purse and one mobile ONE 8 and there are two sims

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in my phone whose numbers are 9255101202 and second one is 8295260150 and due to nervousness I was not able to note down registration number/marka of motorcycle. Unknown motorcycle rider has snatched my purse and action be taken against him. Applicant signatures Kanta Rani wife of Satish Kumar resident of H.No. 81 DC Colony Hisar 9215572996. Dated 17.04.2023.”

3. As per the prosecution, there is a CCTV footage available qua the incident in question and the petitioner is visible in the said CCTV footage, where he can be seen snatching the bag of the complainant.
4. The petitioner has clean antecedents. Investigation already stands concluded. Challan stands presented. The veracity of the CCTV footage will definitely be matter of trial.
5. Keeping in view of above, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
6. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
