1. The present petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating order dated 02.11.2012, passed by this Court in Civil Revision No. 3946 of 2006.
2. It is not even disputed by counsel for the petitioner that a sum of Rs.1,00,000/-, specifically mentioned in order dated 02.11.2012, passed by this Court in CR 3646-2006, has already been disbursed to the petitioner, *namely*, Krishan Lal. However, with regard to any other amount, the High Court itself directed in the order that the same shall be recovered by the executing Court from the respondents, in accordance with law. Since, the execution petition is still pending, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
4. However, dismissal of the present contempt petition would not be taken as adverse to the claim either of the parties in the pending execution.
