RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 22.11.2023 passed in CWP-21614-2016.
2. Perusal of the record shows that the respondent has passed a speaking order relying upon the Rule, and the approval of the Government as permitted under the Rules itself, granted qua requirement of subject combination for the recruitment to the post of the Social Science Master(s). Therefore, it would not be appropriate to proceed further in the contempt petition.
3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the order passed by the respondent, by availing alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
