The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.91 dated 03.12.2023 under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149, 427 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka.

Reply by way of affidavit dated 22.2.2024 of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Abohar (Rural), District Fazilka filed today in the Court is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submit that pursuant to the interim order dated 12.01.2024 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 12.01.2024 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 12.01.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
