1. The petitioner has approached this Court by way of filing the present writ petition impugning the order dated 05.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) whereby the petitioner has been transferred from 66 KV Sub Station Sarawan to 66 KV Sub Station Golewala. The grievance of the petitioner is that the said transfer has been made just after 23 days of his earlier transfer which was ordered vide order dated 09.11.2023 (Annexure P-1). In the impugned transfer order, it has been stated that he has been transferred on his request (own interest) whereas he has not submitted any request for his transfer, although the earlier transfer was made on his own request.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Gagneshwar Walia, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 05.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) to the

respondents against the impugned transfer order dated 05.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) and he would be satisfied if the same is considered by respondent No. 2-Chief Engineer, P&M Zone, PSPCL, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the respondents is not averse to the prayer made by the counsel for the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No. 2- Chief Engineer, P&M Zone, PSPCL, Ludhiana that if any such representation dated 05.01.2024 (Annexure P-5), as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, that shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of two weeks from today and convey the same to the petitioner.

6. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
