MAIN CASE

The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 to 4 for conducting fair and impartial investigation in case bearing FIR No. 99 dated

29.04.2023, under Sections 323, 324, 341 & 34 of IPC (Sections 326 & 307 of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Haibowal, Ludhiana.

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties are neighbourer being the residents of same street and a settlement has been arrived at between them with the intervention of respectable persons; thus, he does not press the present petition any further and wishes to withdraw the same.

[3] Learned State Counsel has no objection against the aforesaid prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.
