1. Reply on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had rendered enough service to claim the pensionary benefits but his pensionary benefits have not been released, which is causing prejudice to him.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in order to claim the pensionary benefits, the petitioner has already raised the said grievance through the legal notice dated 05.09.2022 (Annexure P-7) and the respondent-Institute be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

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4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No. 3 and 4 submits that appropriate order on the claim of the petitioner as raised in the legal notice dated 05.09.2022 (Annexure P-7) will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to him otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner, which reasons will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for respondents No. 3 and 4, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
