RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for taking action against the respondents for non-compliance and disobedience of order dated 12.04.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP-23933-2014.

Pursuant to previous order dated 22.11.2023, Mr. Rajiv Ranjan, Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, Labour Department is present in the Court and filed compliance report by way of his affidavit. The same is taken on record. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the financial assistance has already been paid to the petitioner and qua the family pension, the matter has been referred to Accountant General, Haryana for further compliance, subject to decision in LPA-1-2021.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.

Dismissed.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.

Personal appearance of aforesaid officer is exempted.
