1. This second petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.  
seeking grant of post-arrest bail in:-

2. Custody certificate dated 15.05.2024 has been filed by the State  
counsel, which is taken on record. State counsel submits that a recovery of

760 loose tablets of salt Tramadol Hydrochloride with a total weight of 316 grams was effected from the petitioner. Pursuant to the previous order passed by this Court, she has filed affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, District Barnala and submits that the prosecution has concluded its evidence on 08.05.2024 and the proceedings are fixed before the trial Court on 20.05.2024 for recording statement of accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C.

3. In view of the advance stage of trial, prayer made in the petition cannot be acceded to.
4. Petition is dismissed.
