1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of order dated 15.12.2016 passed by this court in RSA-5951-2016.

2. The counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order, qua which the contempt is asserted, was passed in RSA-5951-2016, which has been decided by this court against the respondents.

3. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more. Hence the same stands dismissed.



4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy for realizing the benefits available to him under the decree passed by this court in the regular second appeal, but in accordance with law.
