VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the order dated 09.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No. 1 whereby the application filed by the senior citizen for eviction of the house has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 has submitted that the petitioner has died on 13.04.2022 and has placed on record the death certificate which is taken on record as Mark-A and has submitted that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the counsel is not in touch with the petitioner and thus, the present petition in all probability has been rendered infructuous. She further submits that in case, the said fact is found to be incorrect, then the petitioner be granted liberty to move an application for revival of the present petition, in case any cause survives.

4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, at this stage. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the same in case any cause survives.
