1. Present application has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') seeking withdrawal of the main petition, which is listed for 25.10.2024.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner submits that during pendency of the present petition, a compromise has been effected between the parties and as such, the applicant-petitioner wishes to withdraw the main petition and intends to file a petition seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

3. In view of the above, instant application is allowed. Date of hearing is preponed from 25.10.2024 to today. The main petition is taken on board for final disposal today itself.

5. Present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file a petition seeking quashing of FIR (*supra*) on the basis of compromise.
