DEEPAK SIBAL, J.(ORAL)

1. The respondent joined the Haryana State Electricity Board (for short – the Board) (now Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited) on 03.09.1980 as an Electrician and retired on 30.06.2008 as an Assistant Foreman. His entire service was on work charge basis. In the year 2009, he petitioned this Court seeking regularization of his services in terms of the policy of the Board and in particular the policy dated 08.02.1988 as per which services of all the employees who were on the establishment of the Board, on work charge basis, were to be screened and then made regular.

2. Through the impugned judgment a learned Single Judge of this Court, after concluding that the respondent's case was fully covered under the aforesaid regularization policy of the Board dated 08.02.1988, has



ordered regularization of the services of the respondent and consequently issued directions to grant him pension, along with arrears and interest.

- 3. Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.
- 4. Neither any record was produced before us nor any argument even addressed to show that the case of the respondent for regularization of his services was not covered under the aforesaid policy of the Board dated 08.02.1988. Therefore, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned judgment except to the extent that the arrears ordered to be paid to the respondent through the impugned judgment shall remain restricted to a period of 38 months prior to the filing of the respondent’s writ petition.
- 5. Disposed of in the above terms.
- 6. All pending miscellaneous application(s) also stand disposed of.
