This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the order dated 07.04.2018 (Annexure P-4) vide which the petitioner has been placed under suspension and departmental enquiry has been ordered to be initiated by respondent no.5.

2. On 14.03.2024, this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“Present: None for the petitioner.
Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana.

A written request for adjournment has been circulated on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that he is out of station.

Learned State counsel has submitted that as per her instructions, 8 out of 9 witnesses have been examined in the departmental proceedings. She prays for an adjournment to verify as to whether one witness, who has not been examined in the departmental proceedings, is the common witness in the criminal case or not and in case, he is the common witness,

then as to whether he has been examined in the criminal case or not.
