The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.83, dated 08.09.2023 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323, 324, 506 and 34 of IPC, 1860 (Section 326 of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City, Gardiwal, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1).

This Court vide order dated 19.01.2024, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 19.01.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sarabjeet Singh does not controvert the said fact and further submits that further custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 19.01.2024 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
