This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 29.01.2018 passed by this Court in CWP-1820-2018.

Compliance affidavit of Ms. Preeti, Administrator, HSVP, Rohtak has been filed by learned counsel for the respondent today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the order dated 29.01.2018 passed by this Court in CWP-1820-2018 has been complied with and speaking order dated 25.01.2024 has been passed.
