NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Instant Writ Petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release all the retiral benefits of the petitioner with interest.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.3 – Executive Officer, Nagar Council, Zira, to consider and decide legal notice dated 19.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner.

3. Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.3 that if any such legal notice, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, that shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within three months from

the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

4. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
