All the aforesaid contempt petitions shall stand decided by this common order as common question of facts are involved.

All the contempt petitions have been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 19.02.2018 passed by this Court in CWP-15774-2013 and in other connected writ petitions.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the order regarding grant of benefit of past service has already been complied with qua all the petitioners except qua three petitioners, namely, Jaswant Singh, Balwant Singh Bedi and Tripta Devi. Out of them, records of Jaswant Singh and Balwant Singh Bedi are not available in the office and issue of succession certificate is involved in the case of Tripta Devi.

In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition(s) any more. Hence, the same are dismissed.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner(s) is left un-addressed, he/she would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
