1 This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case F.I.R. No.84 dated 11.08.2023 registered under Sections 177/420/120-B IPC at Police Station Dehlon, Ludhiana.

2 The petitioner who happens to be Numberdar has been alleged to have attested false 'kursinama'.

3 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said 'kursinama' was accompanied by affidavit of co-accused who happens to be the real sister of the complainant. Apart from that it has been submitted that both the sisters i.e. the complainant as well as the main accused have already compromised the matter and are before this Court seeking quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise in ***CRM-M No.2123 of 2024.***

4 Custody certificate has been filed. The same is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner is behind bars for 1 month and 28 days and has clean antecedents.

5 Learned State counsel is not in a position to dispute the
aforementioned factual assertions based on record.

6 I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone
through the records of the case.

7 Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering
the incarceration suffered by the petitioner, the present petition is allowed.
The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety
bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

8 Needless to say that anything observed herein shall not be
construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.
